The guest speaker was Dr Cameron Camp from the USA. I have never heard such an inspirational, captivating speaker. He was brilliant.

His catch phrase being, "Everything you do for me, you take away from me".

You are probably thinking isn't Montessori a child care provider? - well you are right. These same teaching principles are now being used for people living with Dementia.

Dr Camp's philosophy is "what the brain forgets, the hands remember". So it is very important to keep people living with dementia 'doing', 'taking risks' and continuing to be useful members of society.
