
If you see a bus trip or social activity on the monthly calendar that you're interested in, but have services on that day, don't worry we can assist you in rescheduling that service.


We continue to welcome new faces to the social activities and its heart warming to see new friendships develop.

About the Aged Care Quality Standards

Standard 5: Organisation's service environment.

This standard refers to the physical environment the organisation provides for residential care, respite care and day therapy centres. The standard requires that the environment – including the design, accessibility and layout of the building and the furniture and equipment - meet the consumer's needs, is clean, comfortable, safe and secure, welcoming and well maintained.

The Intent of this requirement: This standard is about creating a service environment that is well designed and welcoming for all consumers and encourages a sense of belonging and provides a safe space for consumers to be themselves.
