Home Care news

With summer here, it's time to get fire aware if you live in the hills area or a designated high fire danger area. The CFS is predicting this season will have more thunderstorms with lightning strikes due to the wet winter we had leading to a large amount of moisture staying in the ground. This creates more likelihood of thunderstorms over summer which leads to more lightning strikes, the main cause of bushfires.

What do I do now?

Talk to your coordinator

- Get your Bush Fire Plan updated.
- Organise maintenance of your home and garden in preparation for the fire season. Payment for this service can be accessed through your package funds.
- Organise who your Emergency Contact person is so St Louis Home Care can keep in contact with them if a fire starts. This person is not necessarily your next of kin contact person as they may be unavailable during the daytime if you need to evacuate.
- Organise to purchase an emergency radio/torch unit. St Louis Home Care has them available and the purchase can be accessed through your package funds. The radio is solar powered with a hand crank, USB charging option. This will allow you to access information and charge your devices if there is no electricity. It also has a LED light torch if you get into trouble during the night.

Prepare yourselves

- Get yourself a *Go Bag* packed so you are ready to leave. Packing is the last thing you need to do if you are faced with a fire front approaching.
- Talk to your family about your plan so everyone knows what to do.
